

## **Oral exam for aviation**

### **A sample set**

#### **PART 1** (3 min per student)

Good morning. Welcome to the exam. Please sit down with us.

*To Candidate 1:*

What's your name? Could you tell us something about yourself?

(after a short introduction, the examiner asks a few questions from the list attached)

*To Candidate 2:*

And what about you? Could you introduce yourself briefly?

(after a short introduction, the examiner asks a few questions from the list attached)

#### **PART 2** (4 min for the pair)

Now I'd like you to talk about something for about 4 minutes. (Examiner gives the candidates a sheet of paper with pictures)

**I'd like you to imagine that a local café wants to attract more people. Here are some of the suggestions they are considering.**

- **First, discuss how successful each of those suggestions might be.**
- **Then decide which two would attract most people.**

#### **PART 3** (5 min for the pair)

Now I would like us to talk about this situation for a moment.

(Examiner starts the discussion by asking both candidates questions from the list. The second candidate can be encouraged with questions like, "And what do you think?" Do you agree with your friend? )

- **Would you like to spend time in a café like this? (Why? Why not?)**
- **Would you like to work in a café like that? (Why? Why not?)**
- **What sort of restaurants are most popular in Poland? Why?**
- **What sort of things do people complain about in cafes and restaurants?**
- **Young people usually go to different places to relax than older people. Why do you think that is?**
- **Some people say that going out to relax is a waste of time and money. Do you agree? (Why? Why not?)**
